## MCAE Endorses the Campaign for Our Communities Initiative

MCAE Board of Directors voted to endorse the Campaign for Our Communities Campaign and join the broad coalition of communities, business people, and labor to preserve essential services in a fair and balanaced way. The Campaign for Our Communities seeks progressive tax reform to raise at least \$1 billion in new revenue to help address the state's funding shortfall. A centerpiece of the campaign is legislation sponsored by Senator Sonia Chang-Diaz and Representative Jim O'Day, entitled "An Act to Invest in our Communities".

The act proposes to restore the income tax rate from 5.3% to 5.95%, and includes an increase in personal exemptions enough to hold down increases for middle class families. (\$4,400 single/\$8,800 married to \$7,900 single/\$15,800 married). It also proposes an increase of the dividends and interests rate from 5.3% to 8.95%, with an exemption for low and middle income seniors and disabled persons. This legislation raises revenue to maintain funding for our communities, schools and healthcare.
