Boston Woman Wins Outstanding Student Award

Boston, MA: Immigrants account for almost one-third of all Boston households, and many face severe economic and emotional challenges as they struggle to adapt to a new language, culture and community. Since arriving in the United States from Bulgaria in 2007, Tihilina Kirova has worked hard to overcome those obstacles while simultaneously contributing to her community in Jamaica Plain.

Even when life was extremely difficult, Lina studied diligently in her Distance Learning Class at Jamaica Plain Community Center (JPCC), and later in more advanced classes at Catholic Charities/El Centro del Cardenal. Always a class leader, Lina organized student events, and was chosen to represent her student body during advocacy visits with state legislators.
